## Queen Contest Rules 2024

1. Only girls enrolled in grades 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, and attending school in Willacy County, or residing in Willacy County and enrolled in a 4-H or FFA Club in the County are eligible.
2. Candidate must have never been married or pregnant.
3. Candidate must have parents' written consent to enter contest. (Parent or guardian must sign entry form.)
4. Each applicant's official entry form must be turned into Alison Busse Savage, no later than Friday, January 19 @ 5PM. APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETE.
5. There will be a meeting of all candidates, parents and/or guardians on Friday, January 19th at the Willacy County Livestock Show Barn at 5PM. A short rehearsal will take place at this time. Each candidate will be responsible for her own entry fee of \$40.
7. Candidates MUST wear a western outfit for contest judging. If selected show queen and/or runner-up, western attire must be worn to all functions. Appropriate and tasteful dress is expected.
8. Judges will be selected from outside of Willacy County. Candidates will be judged on their poise and personality (30%), public interview questions (20%), essay (20%), and WCLSF/FFA/4H involvement (30%). Judges will read essays and review resume prior to the contest and will watch as contestants introduce themselves and answer randomly selected questions during the competition. Final judging will be held on Saturday, January 20, 6:30PM.

THE WCLS RESERVES TO ITS OFFICERS AND/OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS THE FINAL AND ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO INTERPRET THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS AND ARBITRARILY SETTLE AND DETERMINE ALL MATTERS, QUESTIONS AND DIFFERENCES IN REGARD THERETO OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF, CONNECTION WITH, OR INCIDENT TO THE FAIR QUEEN CONTEST.
