Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair Scholarship

The Willacy County Fair understands that education is vital to the American agriculture industry. We support our Willacy County youth by providing them a venue for competition and a market for their junior agricultural and livestock projects.

The Willacy County Fair Scholarship was established to encourage 4-H and FFA students to continue their education after high school graduation. The scholarship is for the recipient's educational expenses and shall be awarded by the Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair scholarship committee to a graduating senior/seniors who meet the following requirement:

- 1. The applicant will have participated/be participating in the Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair organization for three of their four years in high school.
- 2. The applicant will be a current Willacy County 4-H/FFA member in good standing with their respective club/chapter.
- 3. Recipient agrees that they will not, at any time during or after the award, make any statement, whether oral or in writing, including on any social media platform (e.g., Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, X), that disparages, defames, or otherwise damages the reputation, goodwill, or standing of the Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair, its products, services, officers, board members, or volunteers.

APPLICATION

Those senior students who are eligible shall apply by properly completing the application which can be picked up at the Willacy County Extension office or with your Willacy County high school ag teacher. The application, along with transcripts, are to be turned in to the Willacy County Extension office OR to your ag teacher before 5:00 pm on Wed., Jan 7th, 2026.

SELECTION

A Scholarship committee will be appointed by the Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair. This committee will review all applications and select the most deserving recipient(s) to award the Scholarship to. Winners will be introduced at the 2026 Willacy County Livestock Show Premium Sale.

RECIPIENT'S AGREEMENT

The winner(s) of this scholarship must agree to the following stipulations:

- 1. The recipient shall enter college or vocational school as a full time student not later than September following graduation from high school; unless at the discretion of the scholarship committee a justifiable reason exists to enter in the January semester.
- 2. Willacy County Livestock Show & Fair will issue a check in the amount of the scholarship awarded, directly to recipient to offset the cost of bills, tuition, fees, books and other school essentials. Proof of enrollment must be provided before check is issued.
